**Subject:** Price Increase –Effective 15-April-2021

Our resin suppliers have a previously announced increase nominated for March 1st. This increase is in addition to previously implemented resin increases in December 2020, January 2021, and February 2021. A recent extreme cold weather event in the US Gulf Coast region has led to significant unplanned outages in the production of olefins. These unplanned outages at their peak, represented approximately 70% of North American PE production (90% of total US production) and has inflamed what was already an extremely tight supply environment. Several of our resin suppliers have declared force majeure or some sort of sales allocation.

**In response to this March resin increase and other rising costs, Mercury Plastics will implement a price increase of 8% effective with all new orders placed on or after April 15, 2021.**

**All orders must call for normal delivery lead times.**

**Mercury Plastics reserves the right to limit order quantities to normal usage. This ensures consistent quality of service and availability to all our customers.**
